**Student mobility for studies
from the University of Iringa (UoI), Tanzania
to the Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE), Germany**

General overview:

The Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE) offers in the field of **Social and Cultural Anthropology**

- **4 student mobilities for studies** (Master students from UoI to UGOE) with a duration of **5 months each**.

The mobility programme offers Master students in Tourism, Culture and Society from the UoI the opportunity of an exchange semester at the Goettingen Institute of Social and Cultural Anthropology (GISCA). The exchange will be based on the museum cooperation between the UoI/Iringa Boma and the Ethnographic Collection at GISCA, involving the grantees in theoretical courses as well as practical projects of collection object research and exhibition design. Selected grantees will also be given the opportunity to develop their individual Master's dissertation research projects during their stay at UGoe.

Costs involved:

Insurance

In line with German legislation, all incoming international students are required to get a German public health insurance for the duration of their stay. The public health insurance costs approx. 100 € per month which has to be paid from your individual support. Accepted grantees will be informed upon arrival on how to get this insurance. In addition, during possible gap days between arrival in Germany and acquisition of the public insurance, the grantees will be insured by a group insurance organized by the Project Coordination Team at a cost of approx. 0,99 EUR per day, which will be deducted from the grantees' individual support.

In the framework of this call for applications within the Erasmus+ Programme, persons with disadvantaged backgrounds are strongly encouraged to apply and, in cases of equal qualification, aptitude and expertise, they will be given preferential consideration in selection. The Erasmus+ Programme promotes equal opportunities and inclusion for all participants regardless of gender, age, sexual orientation, religion or ideology, disability and chronic illness, ethnic and social background. The actions aim at facilitating the access to the participants with disadvantaged groups and special needs. The University of Göttingen and University of Iringa (UoI) recognize that faculty, staff, and students need an environment in which they are respected and valued for their contributions in order to work and study effectively. This applies irrespective of their age, (dis)ability, gender, sexual orientation or identity, marriage and civil partnership, pregnancy and maternity, ethnic origin, and religion and belief.



Semester fees

The receiving institution will not ask the grantee to pay tuition fees. However, the grantee will be charged the same non-tuition semester fees as local students for costs such as student unions and the use of study-related materials or equipment, including a semester ticket for public transport in Goettingen and the entire state of Lower Saxony. The grantee has to pay these fees of approx. 320 EUR from the individual support.
